COURSE INFORMATION & UPDATES

- Swim:** Clockwise swim starting and finishing from the beach. Swim caps must be worn and no flotation devices of any kind will be allowed.
- Bike:** The bike course is gently rolling country roads, with surfaces being a mix of asphalt and concrete. Turns will be marked with brightly colored duct tape.
- Run:** The run course is flat and fast around Lake Andrea. The Olympic distance will have a section of crushed gravel trail.

AID STATIONS & RESTROOMS

Restrooms will be available in the front of the building, in transition, and at the finish line.

- Transition Aid Station:** Water
- Sprint Run Aid Station:** Located at approximately miles 1.5 and 2.3. Stocked with water, Heed, and Gels.
- Olympic Run Aid Station:** Located at approximately miles 1.5, 2.3, 4, and 5.3. Stocked with water, Heed, and Gels.

POST RACE FOOD & REFRESHMENTS

- Sandwiches, courtesy of Panera Bread, will be available at the finish.
- Water, courtesy of Festival Foods, will be available immediately after the finish.
- Each participant (21 and older) will receive two FREE beers from Hop Haus Brewing Company at the post race party. Per village regulations, beer will be served starting at 11 AM.
- Indigo Canyon will be playing live music from 10 AM - 1 PM.
- Awards will take place near the finish line starting at 10:30 AM.
